CANDIDATE PROFILE

We are looking for highly qualified and motivated researchers to join **RESURBE working groups**, and to co-author articles within **Springer Resilient Cities book series**.

We are looking for candidates at different stages of their career:

<p>Early career researchers, 0-5 years' experience Typically PhD candidates and Postdocs.</p>
<p>Established researchers, 5-10 year' experience Typically Assistant Professors, Research Fellows and Lecturers</p>
<p>Leading researchers, >10 years' experience Typically Associate Professors, Senior Research Fellow, Senior lecturers and Professors</p>

The successful candidates will be assigned, depending on experience, to specific tasks in the working groups, which could include leading and coordination roles.

The successful candidates will have the opportunity to co-develop their research in a highly collaborative international environment, and having the opportunity to co-author outputs of the highest academic standards, as the Resilience Cities book series, conferences and/or ISI journal articles.

SUBMISSION

For the submission you will have to send the following documents:

- **Contact details**, as name, surname, current position, and contact details; and indicating up-two Working Groups you are willing to join.
- **Motivation letter**, explaining why and how you are willing to contribute to RESURBE, defining also your time availability and foreseen dedication (400 words max.)
- **Research proposal**, it should refer specifically 1-2 WGs, and include a clear description of your current research projects and future plans (400 words max.)
- **Curriculum Vitae**, including a list of publications.

The documents should be submitted by email as 1 single PDF file*

- first page for the **contact details**,
- second page is for the **motivation letter**,
- third page is for the **research proposal**,
- the following pages are for your **Curriculum Vitae**.

The file name should be as following: RESURBE_Call2015-1_Surname_Name**.pdf*

The email shall be received **not later than 29th March (23.59 UTC+1)**, addressed to: brent.villanueva@upc.edu using “RESURBE Call 2015-1” as subject.

The application can be submitted **in English or Spanish**.
